An effective treatment for restoring thickened and discoloured nails combining Laser treatment with specialised equipment to remodel the nails to a normal thickness and shape.

Our treatment comprises three parts firstly to repair and re-model the damaged nails, we then treat the nails by Laser and then finally carry out preventative treatment to stop re-infection

REPAIRING THE NAILS

We repair the nails using special equipment to remove the infected top layer of nail to expose the healthier nail underneath. This treatment provides an immediate significant benefit to the Patient in the appearance of the nails and making it easier for cutting. This treatment is completely painless.

THE LASER TREATMENT

For this treatment we use two laser applications. Firstly we use a special Laser probe to treat the newly exposed nail surface. We then re treat each nail with a second more powerful probe which penetrates into the nail, underlying tissue and the nail root.

PREVENTATIVE TREATMENT

The Fungus associated with nails is closely related to Athletes foot. To ensure there is no presence of the fungus in the foot we use a third Laser probe to treat the whole general area of the fore foot above and below. We will then prescribe a topical medication for painting onto the nails to prevent re-infection from contaminated footwear.

TREATMENT COSTS

Treatment is normally carried out in a single session and is subject to our standard session charge (£35) plus an additional charge for the treatment starting from only £40

Common questions:

IS THE TREATMENT SAFE? The treatment is completely safe and without side effects and is carried out by fully qualified Practitioners trained in the use of the equipment. Both the Patient and Practitioner are required to wear special spectacles to protect the eyes from any reflected Laser light and Patients with light sensitivity or epilepsy may require blanking of the eyes. Patients on immune suppressant medication may not be treated.

IS A SINGLE TREATMENT SUFFICIENT?

As with all medical conditions the more severe and prolonged the problem the more treatment it is likely to take to resolve. After treatment we ask you to come back in two months time so that we can review progress with both the existing nail and the new nail growth.

Whilst Patients vary in their responses typically light infection may resolve in a single treatment. The more severe and prolonged the damage the more treatment is likely to be required.

Other than oral medication with its possible side effect implications this is the first really effective treatment for this very difficult condition.

All treatment is carried out by qualified Chiropodists/Podiatrists and Foot Health Professionals fully trained and qualified in the use of the equipment and procedures
