We now provide a range of clinical procedures within the Clinic carried out by highly skilled and fully qualified Podiatrists. We utilise the very latest medical equipment ensuring the Patient experiences the minimum of upheaval to every day life.

INGROWN NAIL SURGERY

In grown toenails can become a source of continual discomfort if left untreated. At the MK Clinic we use procedures ensuring only the minimal amount of nail is removed, thereby promoting rapid repair to the treated area and the minimal of visual disruption to the nail and toe. To prevent the nail re-growing used to involve the use of highly toxic chemicals. At the Clinic we use the very latest Radio Surgical equipment. This involves no chemicals and ensures long term control of the nail re-growth to avoid re-occurrence.

The procedure involves an initial assessment of the condition where we will assess whether surgery is necessary. In many cases we are able to resolve the problem in this initial session by skilful use of the specialised equipment we have available. If a full procedure is required you will typically be in the Clinic for around 90 minutes, of which the procedure itself only takes a few minutes. The procedure is carried out under Local Anaesthetic. To ensure rapid healing as part of the ongoing aftercare we include three free redressing sessions.

CLINICAL EXCISION OF VERRUCAE

In the past physical excision of Verrucas was not viable. Scalpel excision can lead to significant scarring and reoccurrence rates were very high. At the Clinic we now have the very latest AcuSect surgical equipment which provides us with the ability to carry out excision with great accuracy and precision. In addition the cauterising affect of the treatment leads to dramatically improved healing and low reoccurrence. We include follow up after care for treatment with our medical lasers for rapid tissue repair and eradication of any remaining virus. This combination of treatments provides the Patient with the minimum of disruption and discomfort.

PAINFUL RECURRING CORNS

Do you have painful reoccurring corns which typically come back after only a short time? Our AcuSect is the very latest medical equipment providing a more lasting clinical solution to this problem of recurring and neurovascular corns.

As with the Verrucae treatment the procedure is carried out under local anaesthetic and requires the Patient to be with us for an hour or so with a follow up redressing the following day.

TREATMENT COSTS

Patients will require an initial consultation (£29-£35) to assess their suitability for the procedure. Surgery is carried out weekday mornings and usually requires the Patient to be in the Clinic for around 90 minutes. Patients will require someone to drive them home and will need to rest their foot for the remaining part of the day. Cost of surgery typically starts from £230 including full aftercare and redressing treatment

All treatments are carried out by our team of Podiatrists fully trained and qualified in the procedures and equipment used. They are assisted by fully trained nursing staff.
